Uplands Master Naturalist Class by UF/IFAS Extension

The University of Florida, Okaloosa & Walton County Extension Office will be offering a condensed **Uplands Master Naturalist** class this summer. Adults 18 and up are encouraged to attend an exciting class full of instruction, field trips, and guest speakers during the **40 hour course**. Training includes ecosystem processes, identification of key plants and wildlife, and the role of humans in shaping Florida's environment, interpretation skills, and environmental ethics. The upland module will be taught **July 15-23 (excludes July 20 and 21, no class)**. The **cost is \$225**, which includes materials, instruction and three field trips. **Registration closes July 9**.
