Destin-Fort Walton Beach Airport (VPS) Welcomes Inaugural Flight from D.C.'s Reagan National Airport

Airport employees set up a temporary welcome center to receive the passengers aboard an American Airlines new Embraer 175 jet as it landed at Florida's fastest-growing airport Friday morning at about 10 AM.

The inaugural flight, which has been planned for months means Eglin's military personnel and civil servants now have a hassle-free daily-direct commute to Washington D.C.

The new flight, which is pegged to bring in another 50,000 visitors to the Emerald Coast, will open up a direct market for our local tourism businesses to encourage the Mid-Atlantic Seaboard to visit our warm shores for much-needed vacations with a flight time of two (2) hours!
